

Development Consent Orders – "DCOs"

- Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIPs)
- England and Wales
- 'Single' consent per project, can include compulsory acquisition and highways powers
- Statutory Instrument the DCO
- National Policy Statements NPSs
- Six Stages



* these are maximum statutory periods
