Response to: Environmental principles, governance and biodiversity targets: White Paper

We note "Welsh Government proposes that the Bill includes a duty upon the Welsh Ministers to publish guidance to explain how the environmental principles are intended to be interpreted." We also understand the "guidance will be based on well-understood meanings of the environmental principles drawn from relevant sources including case law".

Guidance along with a clear and transparent system and transition are important when making change to decision making requirements. These go hand in hand to prevent uncertainty and confusion in the planning process or in enforcement duties by regulatory bodies. This is all the more important given current capacity issues in planning and the supporting, wider sectors including Natural Resources Wales.

While this appears useful in principle, the lack of further information on the guidance at this stage, makes a comprehensive and informed response difficult. Where the intention is to make changes rather than simply reinstate EU legislation, it would be helpful if the differences and their meaning and the reason are explicitly communicated.

From a planning perspective, we assume, if the Principles will exist in legislation then they will be a material consideration in planning determinations, similar to the habitat regulations and Wellbeing Act etc.

Further information on the relationship between the Principles and 'Planning Policy Wales' or 'Future Wales: The National Plan 2040' is also important and will inform Local Planning Authorities, PEDW and all stakeholders on how the principles will need to be dealt with at a local level, through Local Development Plans or new Strategic Development Plans.
